

## Class Spotlight: Dance II








We love so much about our IWA class offerings, particularly that we have myriad opportunities for our students to learn about the fine arts. We stopped into Ms. Cloe Leppard's Dance II class, where she and her students had just completed a unit on Jazz. The class studies all forms of dance, including ballet, modern and musical theatre, exploring their evolutions and different styles within each genre. Jazz is a melting pot of dance styles, incorporating techniques from ballet, tap and more, with students learning several crossover steps such as grand jetes, travel steps like "the chase" and turns. "Jazz is important because it's the most-seen style of dance," Leppard explained. "Jazz can be found in Broadway performances, TV shows, movies, even TikTok. This is the style the girls really get into, enjoy and ultimately connect with the most." Dance I and Dance II are electives, open to all students.

#### Freshman Retreat



The Freshman Retreat is Friday, Sept. 24. Students will arrive on campus and check in with their designated chaperone. We will then walk over to the Co-Cathedral of the Sacred Heart. This year's retreat theme is modeled after Dr. Seuss' "The Lorax" and will include testimonies by upperclassmen, small groups and prayer activities.
