IWA Students Take Advantage of STEM Opportunities







One of the things we're most proud of at IWA is our rich STEM curriculum. We offer 24 different science, technology, engineering and math courses, seven of which are AP courses. We love providing these opportunities for our students. Earlier this week, science department chair, Ms. Christine Westman sent a note to our school community informing us that we have an unprecedented number of juniors and seniors who have decided to "double up" on their science courses. Thirty-seven percent of the Class of 2022 is taking two science classes this year, while 42% of the Class of 2023 is doing the same. "I began keeping track of this three years ago and each year the percentage has continued to increase," said Westman. "I commend these young women for their willingness to challenge themselves as they follow their interest in STEM courses. I'm also proud to work alongside colleagues, both past and present, who have inspired and encouraged our young women to fearlessly pursue their dreams."
